A NOTE FROM THE VICAR

Dear Friends

This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all 1 John 1:5



On Wednesday March 20th @7.30pm, around 50 people joined together to pray, to light a gospel beacon and for a very special moment, sense God's Holy Spirit at work. The joining together of the Parish with 1 & 2 Saintfield Presbyterian Churches was in response to the 'Beacon' initiative of the Diocese to replicate the beacon St Patrick lit on an Easter Eve 1600 years ago, to challenge the fire the Pagan King of Ireland had lit on the Hill of Slane.. It was said, that if Patrick's fire would not go out, then the light of the Gospel would never leave Ireland.

As we met together to witness this light in action, we could see how this light not only lit the path outside the Church, but also how it lit up everyone around it. That when we meet together in Jesus' name, the Holy Spirit will always change how we see the world around us and how Christians see each other. Myself, Sam Bostock and John Torrens are convinced that our churches can allow this light to burn brighter through what we can tell of Jesus.

Next February, Rico Tice will be joining with us for a weekend of such sharing and mission. Each of our churches will be used to host events that will not just be Church Services or only listening to God speak through Rico, but to engage with God in different ways. We are planning prayer nights later in the year and we are preparing publicity that will be delivered to every house in Saintfield District. We are also planning a possible evening with Rico in the Autumn to help grow in prayer and to be equipped to be the Light of Jesus that we have been called to be.

It is exciting for our Churches to belong together in such a way. Please pray that God will start to prepare hearts for those who still live in darkness and shadows, to allow the Gospel light to bring fire into their hearts and to know of God's love for them.

LATEST UPDATE

Our update on our SAMS partner church in La Paz concerns an unfortunate collapsing of an outside wall due to flooding.

Pastor David sent through these images to show what happened at the beginning of March. The need to replace the wall is immediate to ensure protection from future flooding as well as to secure the site. The cost is \$800. We are going to send £250 to help in the rebuilding of the wall and hopefully through other partner churches, the wall can be rebuilt quickly.

Over Lent, we have been using the SAMS Ireland 40 days of prayer. This is a prayer list that can be used at any time. We are going to grow in our prayer life for La Rendentor Church with 1 Sunday a month being a focus for prayer and updates.
